



Call for MSc students, PhD students, Residents, Postdoctoral fellows, Research Professionnals and Regular Members to apply to – ANZOS-ASLM-ICCR 2019 - A joint National and International Conference on Obesity and Related Chronic Diseases

Created in April 2012 by the Fond de Recherche du Quebec – Santé (FRQ-S), the **Research Network on CardioMetabolic health, Diabetes and Obesity** aims to promote research excellence, knowledge development and knowledge sharing in these areas to improve the quality of life of Quebecers

The network launches a call to Master and PhD students, Residents, Postdoctoral Fellows, Research Professionals and Regular Members to enter the contest – *ANZOS-ASLM-ICCR 2019 - A joint National and International Conference on Obesity and Related Chronic Disease*, convention to be held **October 16-18, 2019 at the International Convention Centre, Sydney, Australia** (*meeting information: <u>http://anzos-aslm-iccr.org/</u>). The four(4) selected candidates must make an oral or poster presentation (<i>determined by the organization of the congress*).

The congress describes itself as follows: *This conference will feature a diverse and vibrant group of established international and national experts.* You will have direct access to opinion-leaders, experts and key decision makers which will afford an invaluable opportunity to gain knowledge, foster relationships and create networks.

The CMDO Network will refund up to \$1750 to the participant for the transportation, accomodations and/or inscription costs. <u>All other costs</u> shall be borne by the participant and/or its director.

The CMDO Network is associated with the International Research Chair in Cardiometabolic Risk (ICCR - Director: Jean-Pierre Després). This Chair organizes an annual international conference and the network contributes to it actively, through the participation of its members as lecturers or participants as well as through its support for scientific activities.

The deadline for submitting applications is June 14, 2019.

The eligibility criteria and the method of evaluation are described below. Applications submitted late, incomplete or which do not meet the eligibility criteria will not be evaluated. Selected applicants will be contacted **no later than June 20**th.

Eligibility criteria :

1) Be a Master student, PhD student, Resident, Postdoctoral Fellow, or Research Professional whose research director is a **regular member** of the CMDO Network. The research director





must be a member of the network before applying to the competition. **Regular CMDO members** are also eligible for this competition.

- 2) Have a research project related to cardiometabolic health, diabetes and/or obesity.
- 3) Excellence and implication :
 - a. Depending on the CV provided (FRQS CV with detailed contributions section).
- 4) For Students/Trainees Demonstrate a motivation to pursue a research career in one of the Network's theme areas: Cardiometabolic Health, Diabetes and Obesity.
- 5) Selected participants will be required to submit a scientific abstract at this conference which will take place from 16 to 18 October 2019 in Sydney, Australia (deadline for abstract submission: June 21st 2019)
- 6) Please note that a Student/Trainee/Resident/Research Professional/Regular Member can only be a winner for the ICCR meeting competition once.

- 1) Competition application form *ANZOS-ASLM-ICCR 2019* completed online (see below). For Students This document includes the research director's letter of support (*this letter can be included in the form directly or communicated (in PDF format) by email to concours@rrcmdo.ca*).
- 2) *Curriculum vitae* FRQS version (*with detailed contributions section*) of the candidate. Communicate this document directly to concours@rrcmdo.ca.

Application Assessment Process:

The executive committee of the network will evaluate all applications submitted. Contest results will be announced **by June 20th**.
