Supported by the acquisition of new data in 2023-2024 (genotyping chip, medico-administrative data, survivor follow-up), several research opportunities related to the themes of CMDO and aging will be discussed, as well as how researchers can access to these research banks.

## Presentation of the MetaboHUB project and the contribution of metabolomics as a phenotyping tool

This part of the webinar aims to present the collaborative project between MetaboHUB and the NuAge Database and Biobank (Comte et al., EBioMed 2021). In particular, in the context of the development of precision medicine/nutrition, the contribution of a multi-platform metabolomic approach for the integrative exploration of metabolic syndrome will be developed. This methodology represents an opportunity for a better understanding of metabolic phenotypes, as well as for the development of new tools for stratification of elderly populations.
